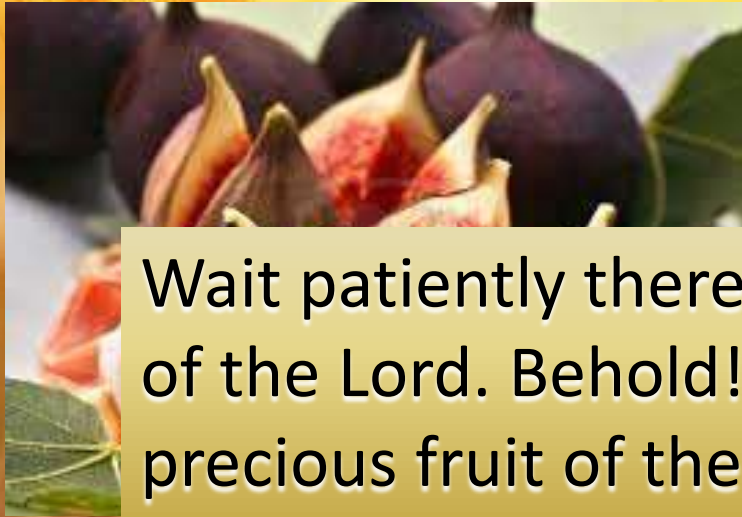

The Seven Feasts of Israel

Leviticus 23

Spring Feasts

1. **The Passover** – Nisan 14 – Passover lamb slain
2. **The Feast of Passover** – Nisan 15 - 21 – Barley 1st fruits offered
3. **The Feast of Weeks (Pentecost)** – 50 days from the day after the Passover Sabbath – 1st fruit of wheat harvest offered

Fall Feasts

4. **The Feast of Trumpets** – 1st day of 7th month – Celebrated civil NY
5. **The Day of Atonement** – 10th day of 7th month – Atoning sacrifices
6. **The Feast of Tabernacles** – 15 day of 7th month – Fall harvest
7. **The 8th day** – Day after Feast of Tabernacles was a “Holy Convocation”

“When you enter the land which I am going to give to you and reap its harvest, then you shall bring in the sheaf of the first fruits of your harvest to the priest. He shall wave the sheaf before the LORD for you to be accepted; on the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it.”

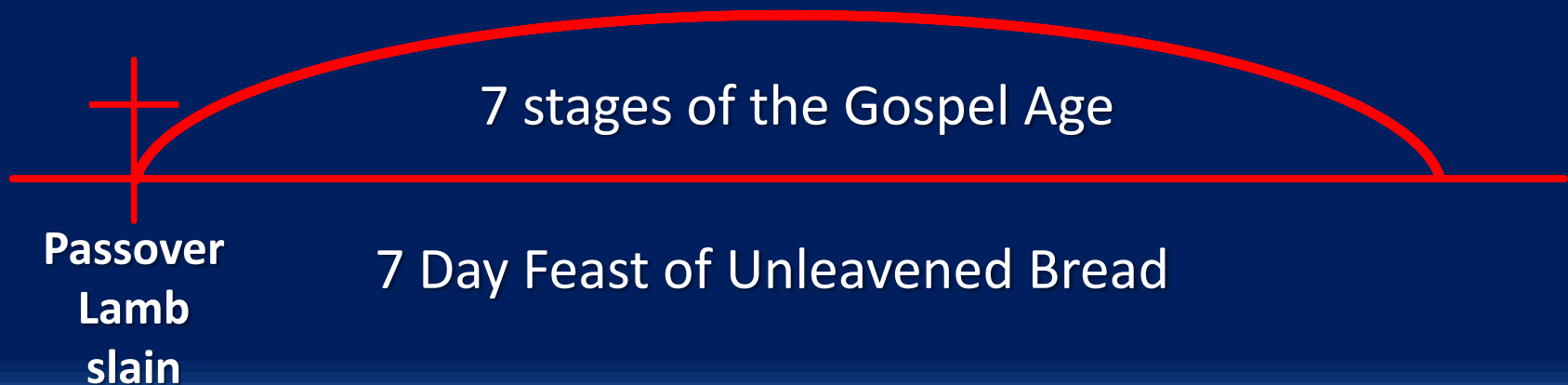

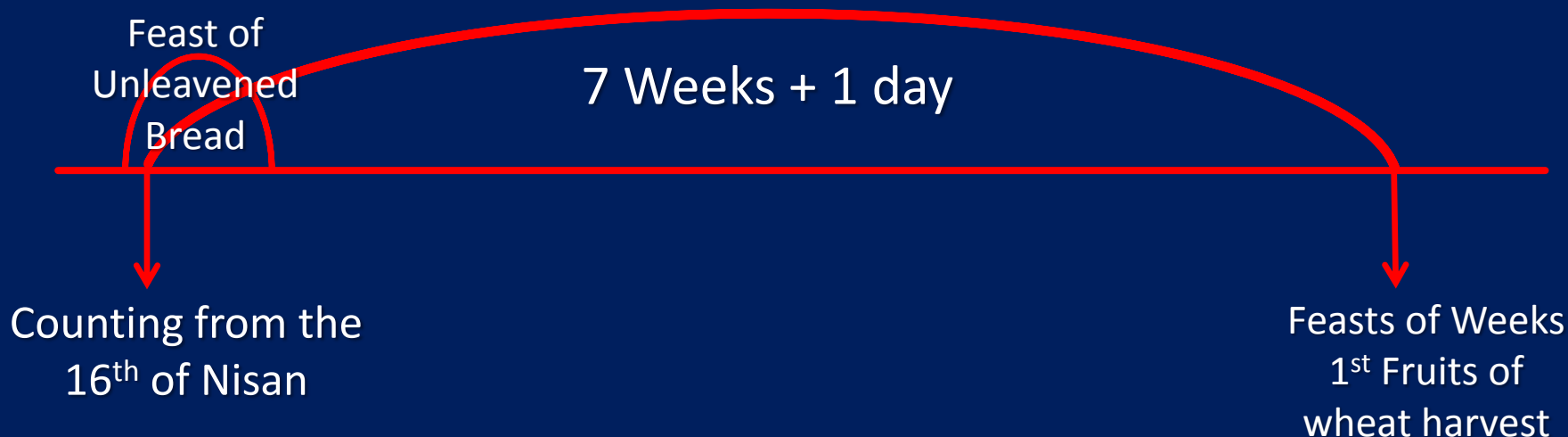

“You shall also count for yourselves from the day after the Sabbath, from the day when you brought in the sheaf of the wave offering; there shall be seven complete Sabbaths. You shall count fifty days to the day after the seventh then you shall present a new grain offering to the LORD.

You shall bring in from your dwelling places two loaves of bread for a wave offering, made of two-tenths of an ephah; they shall be of a fine flour, baked with leaven as first fruits to the LORD.

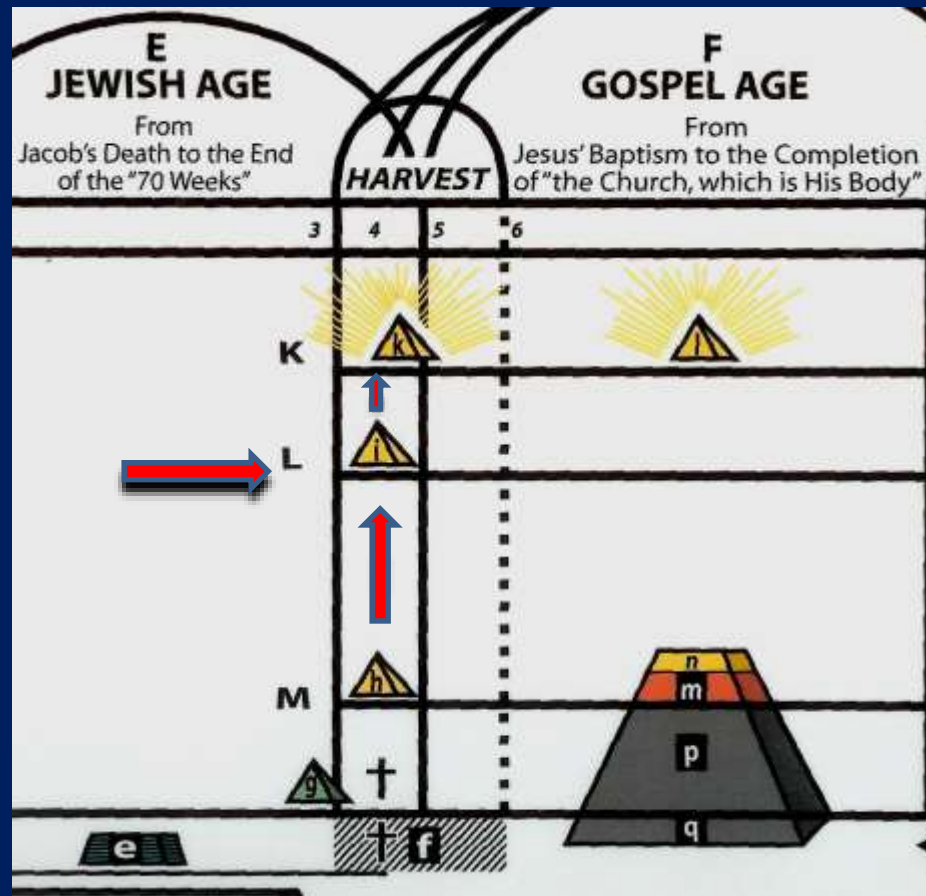

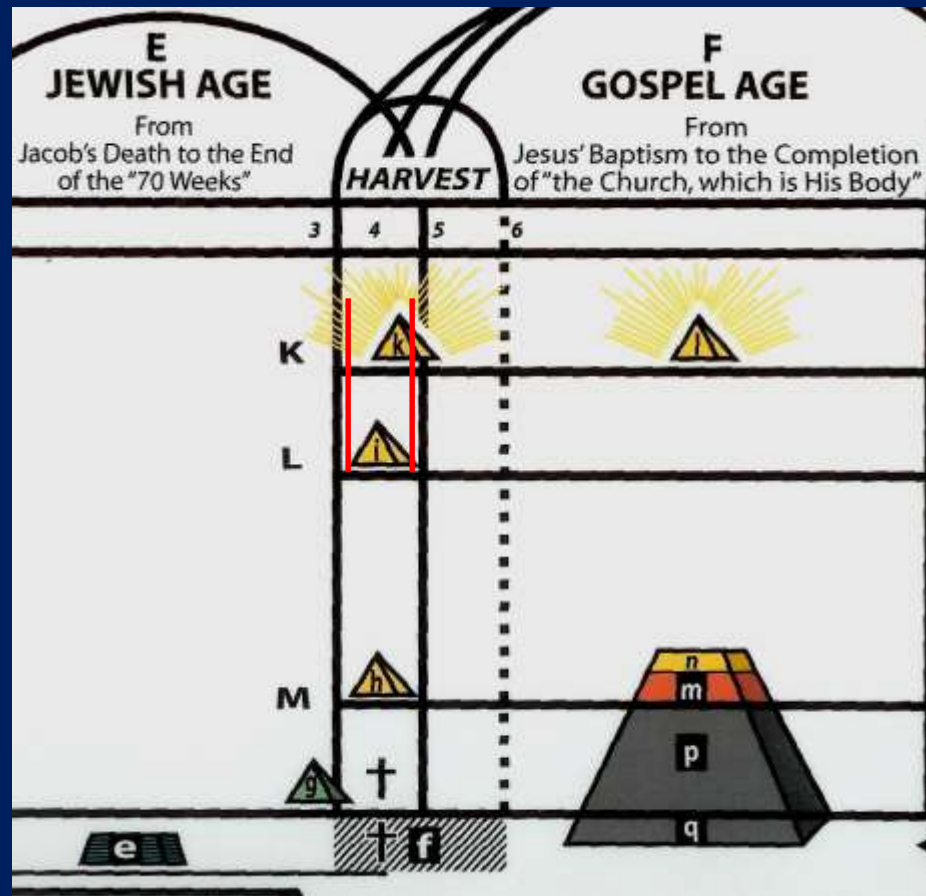

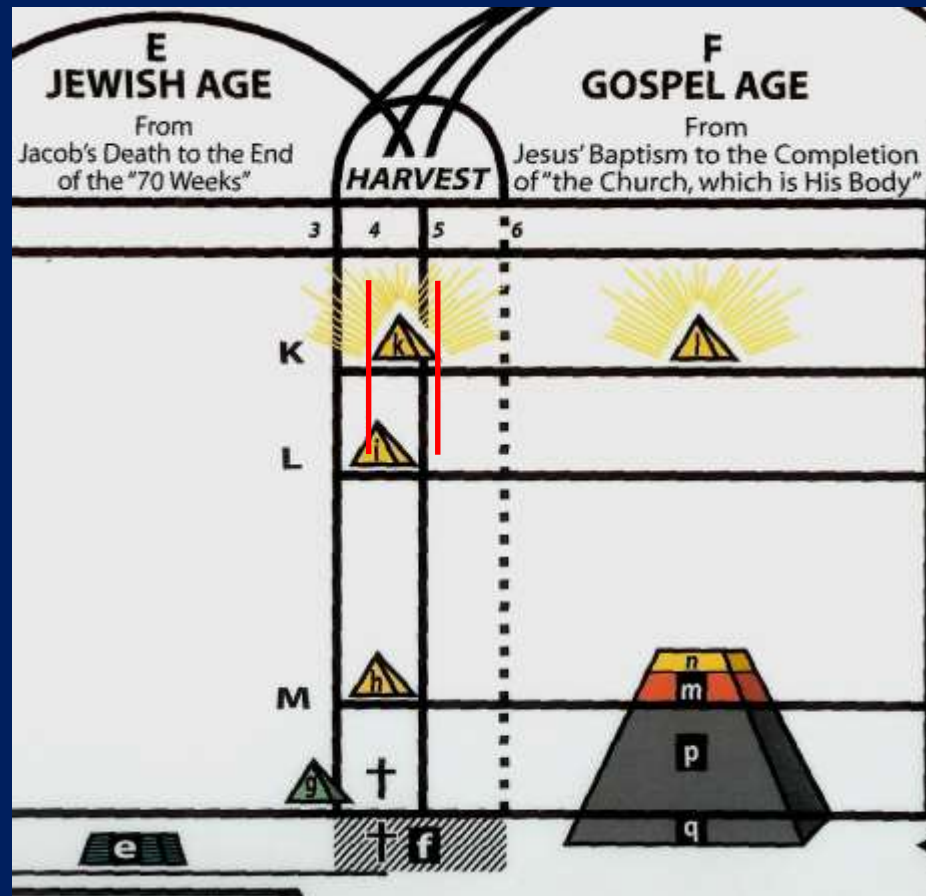
CHAPTER 1
