

# GOD'S "WATERED GARDEN"

11 ... thou [Israel] shalt be like a watered garden—Isaiah 58

22 ... : we [Jews] know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.—John 4

Unless otherwise noted Scripture quotations are from the King James Version with suggested corrections and interpretations.

## DEUTERONOMY 32

1 Give ear, O ye heavens, and I [God] will speak; and hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.

2 My doctrine shall drop as the rain, my speech shall distil as the dew, as the small rain upon the tender herb, and as the showers upon the grass:

## ZECHARIAH 8

13 ... it shall come to pass, that as ye were a curse among the ~~heathen~~\* [peoples], O house of Judah, and house of Israel; so will I [God] save you, and ye shall be a blessing: ... .

## ZECHARIAH 14

8 And it shall be in that day [to come], that living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea [human masses of the east], and half of them toward the hinder sea [human masses of the west]: in summer and in winter shall it be.

## ZECHARIAH 8

3 Thus saith the LORD; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of truth; ... .

## ZECHARIAH 8

22 Yea, many people and strong nations shall come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem, and to pray before the LORD.

## ISAIAH 58

11 And the LORD shall guide thee [Israel (vs. 1)] continually, and satisfy thy soul in drought [drought of truth in the world], ... : and [in the Age-to-Come] thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters [truth] fail not [Israel is to be a new Eden, a "watered garden" for a world in a drought of truth].

## JEREMIAH 31

10 Hear the word of the LORD, O ye ~~nations~~\* [peoples], and declare *it* in the isles afar off, and say, He that scattered Israel will gather him, and keep him, as a shepherd *doth* his flock.

11 For the LORD hath redeemed Jacob, and ransomed him from the hand of *him that was* stronger than he.

12 Therefore they [the peoples (vs. 10)] shall come and sing in the height of Zion, and shall flow together to the goodness of the LORD, for wheat, and for wine, and for oil, and for the young of the flock and of the herd: and their soul shall be as a watered garden; and they shall not sorrow any more at all.

## JOHN 4

22 Ye [Samaritans] worship ye know not what: we [Jews] know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.
