Matt 1:18-25 (NKJV), "...After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit..."




Matt 1:18-25 (NKJV), "... Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not wanting to make her a public example, was minded to put her away secretly..."







Joseph and Mary travel from Nazareth to Bethlehem to register.
