THE HUMAN FRAME

- The **human skeleton** consists of both fused and individual bones. It serves as a scaffold which supports organs, anchors muscles, and protects organs such as the brain, lungs and heart.

BONE FACTS

- What is the biggest bone in the human body ?
- What is the smallest bone ?

BONE FACTS

- The biggest bone is in the thigh called the femur. Your femur is about $\frac{1}{4}$ of your overall height.
- As compared to the smallest bone which is in the middle ear called the Stapes bone and measures only about $\frac{1}{10}$ of an inch.

- At birth, a newborn baby has over (?) bones.

BONE FACTS

- **Number of ribs.**

The number of ribs was noted by the Flemish anatomist Vesalius in his key work of anatomy *De humani corporis fabrica* in 1543, setting off a wave of controversy, as it was traditionally assumed from the Biblical story of Adam and Eve that men's ribs would number one fewer than women's.

Variations in the number of ribs do occur. About 1 in 200-500 people have an additional cervical rib, and there is a female predominance toward this condition.

BONE FACTS

- **Support**

The skeleton provides the framework which supports the body and maintains its shape. The pelvis and associated ligaments and muscles provide a floor for the pelvic structures. Without the ribs, costal cartilages, and the intercostal muscles the heart would collapse.

BONE FACTS

- **Protection**
- The skeleton protects many vital organs:
- The skull protects the brain, the eyes, and the middle and inner ears.
- The vertebrae protects the spinal cord.
- The rib cage, spine, and sternum protect the lungs, heart and major blood vessels.
- The clavicle and scapula protect the shoulder.
- The ilium and spine protect the digestive and urogenital systems and the hip.
- The patella and the ulna protect the knee and the elbow respectively.
- The carpals and tarsals protect the wrist and ankle respectively.

BONE FACTS

- **Movement**

The joints between bones permit movement, some allowing a wider range of movement than others, e.g. the ball and socket joint allows a greater range of movement than the pivot joint at the neck. Movement is powered by skeletal muscles, which are attached to the skeleton at various sites on bones. Muscles, bones, and joints provide the principal mechanics for movement, all coordinated by the nervous system.

- **Are your bones alive?**

Are your bones alive?

- Yes. Bones are made up of living cells which help them grow and repair themselves.
- Like other cells in your body, the bone cells rely on blood to keep them alive. Blood brings them food and oxygen and takes away waste.

- **What is bone marrow?**

What's bone marrow?

- Many bones are hollow. Their hollowness makes bones strong and light. In the center of many bones is bone marrow which produces new red and white blood cells.
- Red blood cells ensure that oxygen is distributed to all parts of your body and white blood cells ensure you are able to fight germs and disease.

BONE FACTS

- 1) In an adult, the skeleton comprises around 30-40% of the total body weight, and half of this weight is water.
- 2) Pound for pound, bone is stronger than steel, and its construction is comparable to reinforced concrete.
- 3) Each human hand has 27 bones; each foot has 26; and your face has 14 separate bones!

- The Jews therefore, because it was the day of preparation, so that the bodies should not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (for that Sabbath was a high {day} , asked Pilate that their legs might be broken, and {that} they might be taken away.
- The soldiers therefore came, and broke the legs of the first man, and of the other man who was crucified with Him; but coming to Jesus, when they saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs; but one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately there came out blood and water.
- And he who has seen has borne witness, and his witness is true; and he knows that he is telling the truth, so that you also may believe.
- For these things came to pass, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, "Not a bone of Him shall be broken."

Scripture cannot be broken

- A primary lesson is that scripture, prophecy, cannot be broken.
- The Jews that hated Jesus were once again the unwitting servants of Satan when they asked Pilate to have the legs of the victims broken.
- But with all of the power that Satan had, and all the desire he had to derail God's work, Satan could not cause a bone of Jesus to be broken, not even one.

"Do you realize that to a child of God, nothing happens by accident? This is so, because "all things work together for their good."

As in the case of the sparrow, "Not one of them shall fall ... without your Father!" Every incident in life has meaning for us and is for our good, for our highest spiritual welfare. It is so different with the world in general. Summary of lessons so far
