FOURTH BOOK: THE BOOK WITH SEVEN SEALS

This book has contents which are secret. The secrets are revealed as the seals are removed. Rev 5:1-3 "And I saw in the right hand of Him who sat on the throne a book with seven seals. And only the lamb is worthy of opening the seals. This book is not the Bible but the Divine Plan conceived even before the foundation of earth. A seal is anything that tightly closes or fastens. Seals prevent openings. It was the seals that prevented the opening and understanding of God's plan during the gospel age. Here is a view of the seven seals and how the lamb opens the seals through seven messengers. Revelation chapters 6, 7 and 8.

Number	Seal	Lamb Opens Seals With Messenger	Seven Trumpet Announcements
1	Gospel restricted to Jews	Paul	Gospel for both Jew and Gentile
2	Pagan Society restricts gospel	John	Gospel converts pagans
3	Gov. restricts gospel to papal system	Arius	Bible held as only authority
4	Papacy restricts gospel to teachers	Waldo	Bible must be opened to all
5	Papacy restricts gospel for all	Wycliffe	Bible written. Door to exit revealed.
6	Papacy restricts protestants for gospel	Luther	Door to leave papacy opened
7	Papacy restricts gospel truths	Russell	Papacy no longer mouthpiece. Come out.

Fifth seal, Lamb shows the door, first woe trumpet—early reformation age (John 10:7)

Sixth seal, Lamb opens the door, second woe trumpet—later reformation age (Rev 3:8)

Seventh seal, Lamb invites to come through the door, third woe trumpet—final reformation age (Rev 18:4)

FIFTH BOOK: THE BOOK OF FAITH

Scriptures imply that not only the names of the saints are written but their lives as well. "To the general assembly and the church of the first born who are written in heaven and the spirits of just men made perfect." (Heb 12:23; I Cor 4:9; Ro 15:4) There are two reasons for recording the biographies of the first-born.

First: Faith is the basis of justification (Ro 3:38) but works measures the strength or greatness of faith which becomes the basis of rewards. In other words, faith gives salvation for the future life but works gives the type of rewards in the future life.

Second: We are learning from the biographies of the prophets, worthies, apostles and disciples at the present time. In the kingdom, the world will learn from 144,000 biographies from the book of faith.

Improper works: uncleanness and impurity 2 Pet 2:10; practices of the flesh Gal 5:19-21; stealing, false witness, blasphemy Matt 15:19; also Matt 6:2-4; I Thess 4:4-7; Eph 5:3-4.

Proper works: practices of the spirit Gal 5:22-23; truth & wisdom Phil 4:8; ministering Heb 6:10; also Matt 28:19-20; I Cor 3:9-15; I Thess 5:12-13.



LESSONS:

1. Knowing the Books will be opened, should we not know well the criteria of the books?
2. Knowing the Books will be opened for others to read, should we not be careful how we live?
3. Knowing the Books will be opened for others to follow example, should we not live extraordinary consecrated lives?
4. Knowing the Books will have blots, should we not help others to maintain their registry?
5. Knowing the Books will record the work within us, should we not assist God in this work?
